Role Summary

The Volunteer Coordinator (VC) is responsible for overseeing the volunteer application process and providing support to new, existing, and prospective volunteers. This community-facing role is an essential part of our team and works to ensure the success and retention of our volunteers.

Responsibilities

- Review volunteer applications and collaborate with team leaders to identify appropriate matches for open roles.
- Serve as a point of contact for volunteer questions and concerns.
- Collaborate with team leaders to identify needs and recruit accordingly.
- Manage volunteer database.
- Maintain role postings on recruitment websites.
- Manage approval and rejection process for applicants.
- Coordinate appreciation efforts (greeting cards, tokens of appreciation).
- The estimated time commitment is 2-3 hours per week.
